

## Patient Navigation Travel Award

In an effort to support continuous learning and career development, Dana-Farber/Harvard Cancer Center (DF/HCC) Initiative to Eliminate Cancer Disparities is pleased to provide funding to active participants in the Patient Navigators Network to participate in cancer education-related conferences.

These travel grants will provide full or partial funds up to \$1000.00 per Patient Navigator to assist with the following expenses:

- Conference registration fees
- Coach airfare to/from the conference
- Hotel accommodations for the length of the conference including non-covered meals
- Transfer to/from the conference venue and airport

Patient Navigators must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- A full-time patient navigator in good standing with their institution
- An active participant in the DF/HCC Patient Navigation Network
- A minimum of one-year as a Patient Navigator
- Must be willing to present conference findings at the next Patient Navigation Network meeting

A successful application will include the following:

- A completed application form which includes your name and contact information including institution.
- Letter of intent which describes:
  - Interest and goals in attending the conference
  - Other efforts to obtain travel funds through your primary institution or the conference, and their response
  - Affiliated institution(s)
- Letter of recommendation from your supervisor
- One-page resume
- A proposed budget including conference registration, airfare and/or ground transportation expenses; uncovered meal expenses
